

2025 Eagle Invitational

Twelve teams are participating in this year's Eagle Invitational. Pool play will be on Friday. Three brackets of tournament play will be all day on Saturday. Each match in pool play will consist of two sets to 25 (cap is 25, first to 25 wins the set). There will be no third set if teams split in pool play. For pool play, we will begin scoring at 4 points each to help stay on schedule. If games finish early, we will try to start the next game as soon as possible.

Seeding will be determined by the number of sets won and lost. If there is a tie, ties will be broken by subtracting "Points Allowed" from "Points Scored".

Bracket play will consist of three levels (Gold, Silver, and Bronze). Top four teams will participate in Gold, middle four will participate in Silver, and last four will participate in Bronze. Bronze will play on Saturday morning beginning at 9:00 in our elementary gym. Silver will play in the new gym beginning at 9:00. Gold will play in the new gym beginning at 1:00.

During pool play, seating will be very limited in the new gym. Please remain outside the gym while your team is waiting to play. There will be an outdoor area for tents if any team is interested in bringing a team tent. We also have the covered portico with plenty of picnic tables. We will have full concessions in the new gym and limited concessions in the elementary gym.

The bracket play will be a single elimination tournament with a consolation game.

For bracket play, the format will be 2 out of 3 sets in each match. First two sets to 25 (win by 2, no cap) and third set, if needed, to 15 (win by two, no cap).

First and Second place plaques will be given at the conclusion of the Gold Bracket. First place plaques for Silver and Bronze Bracket will be given at the conclusion of the morning matches.

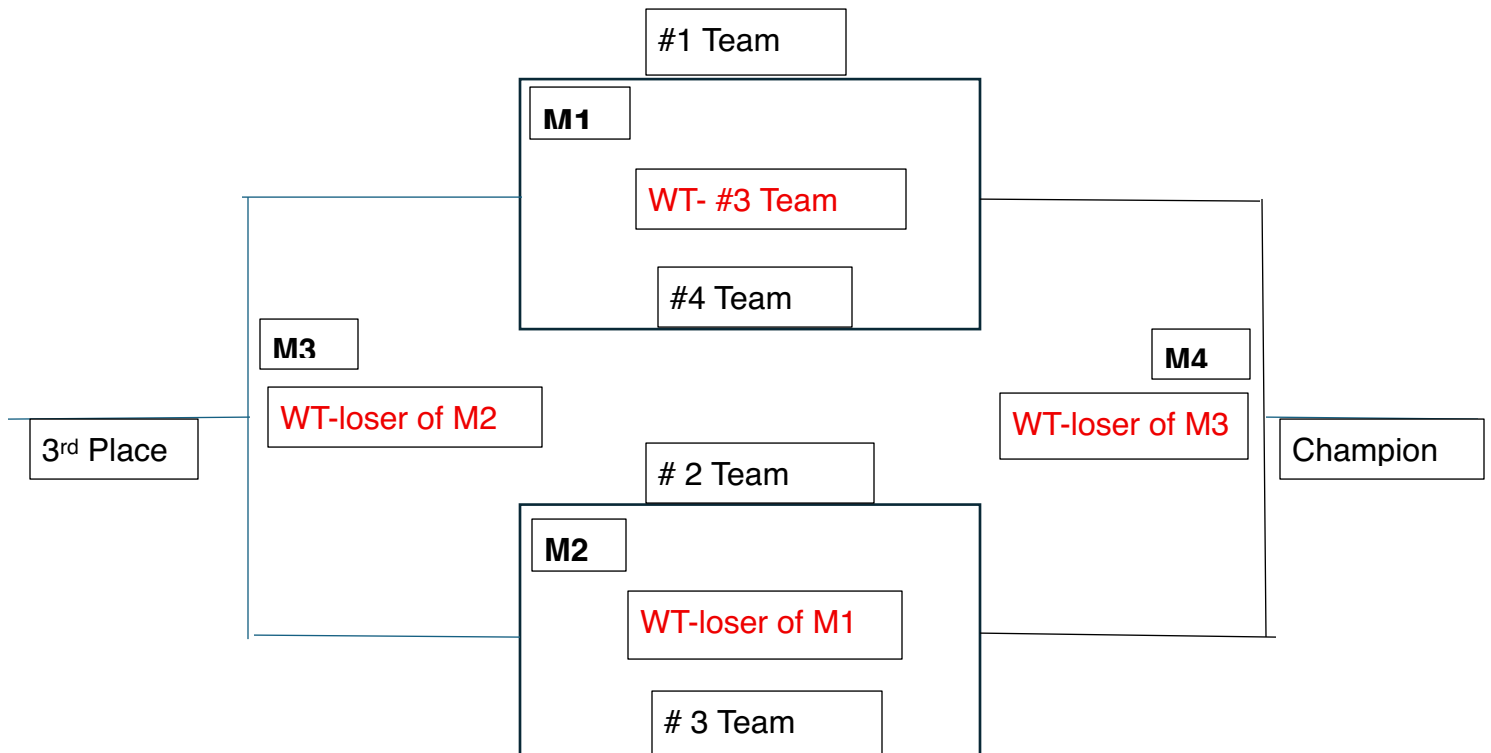
